Eligibility For GNM (Staff Nurse): Pass in 12th Std (10+2) or equivalent examination in any stream, Approved by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and Punjab Nurses Registration Council, Chandigarh.

Eligibility For ANM (M.P.H.W.(F)): Pass in 10th Std or equivalent examination, Approved by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and Punjab Nurses Registration Council, Chandigarh.

Applications are invited on prescribed form along with the following documents which must reach to the principal's office.

- 1. Matriculation Certificate, +1/+2 Higher Secondary Certificate or the previous examination passed.
- 2. Character Certificate from the head of the Institution last attended.
- 3. Detailed Marks Sheet, Migration Certificate.
- 4. Attested copies of SC/ST/BC-Certificate from Executive Magistrate if required.
- 5. Copies of any other documents (Qualification, Sports, Cultural
- 6. Twelve copies of passport size photographs.
- 9. Domicile Certificate.
- 10. The application can be sent by the registered post or can be deposited in college, Incomplete application or received late will not be accepted.

Note: All original educational certificates submitted for selection/Admission will be retained by the Institute until successful completion of the course and will be returned only after clearance of all dues of complete course.

Selection Criteria

- * The Institute will be holding a written test of general knowledge and of 10+2 level syllabus for selection of candidates, a day prior to the date of interview, if found necessary depending upon the number of applications received. Admission shall be made by a selection committee of the Institute.
- The candidates are required to appear for interview/counciling along with original documents on the date as notified.
- Appearing for a written test or interview does not mean the selection of a candidate . No correspondence will be entertained regarding the rejection of a candidate.
- The selected candidates will be informed of their selection. They would be required to deposit the fees immediately after the selection/admission.

Syllabus

The syllabus of G.N.M. and A.N.M. according to INDIAN

Medical Examination

The selected candidates are required to go through a medical examination by any Govt, or private doctor of having minimum qualification of M.B.B.S/B.A.M.S degree. The medical fitness certificate must be presented to the institute at the time of admission.

Session

New session begins according to PUNJAB NURSES REGISTRATION COUNCIL (PNRC) rules.

Preliminary Training Period

On admission to the course, each candidate undergoes a preliminary training period for three months. After training each candidate has to undergo an examination. A minimum of 50% marks are required to get through the examination. Only the successful candidates will continue the course.

Vacations & Holidays

Annual Vacations : 30 days per annum Sick Leave : 10 days per annum Preparatory Leave: 7 days per annum

Disciplinary Action

Students will be terminated from Institute for disobedience of the rules & regulations prescribed by the Institute.

Examination Fees

The students shall be required to pay themselves the fee to the Punjab Nurses Registration Council for Examination conducted by the Council through the Institution.

Examination Results

The following gradation is awarded on the aggregate marks obtained during three years performance:

Eligibility For Admission To Examination

A candidate shall be eligible for admission to the examination if; The Head of the School certifies that:

- 1. She/He has completed not less than eleven months of the course and that her overall performance has been satisfactory during that period.
- 2. She/He has attended 75% classes both in theory and Practical. If Attendance falls short, she/he will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 3. Minimum pass percentage is 50% in aggregate (Internal, External and

Registration

The Successful candidates in the final year examination are eligible for registration with the council after paying the council's fee through Institute.

- i) The institute reserves the right to alter the rules & regulations from time to time. Fee and all other charges once paid by the candidates will not be refunded in any circumstances. Candidates are required to submit the instalment immediately after getting the selection/admission.
- Student will be relieved from the school and certificate with Marks Card will be handed over to the student onlyafter all the obligations to the school are fulfilled.
- iii) Migration is not permissible in any circumstances.
- Parents/Guardians of students are personally liable for all the dues etc. out-standing against their wards.
- Receipts must be obtained for payments. Without Receipt, no payment will be valid.
- Only those candidates should apply who can afford the expenses.
- Fees to be paid by the 7th day of the month failing which the student will have to pay Rs. 50 per day as fine for late payments.
- For educational tours, camps & curricular activities fees are compulsory every year.
- If the candidate leaves the Institution during the training period for any reason whatsoever may be, she/he has to pay all dues of full training course.

Rules And Regulations of The Institution

- Students shall abide by rules and regulations, maintain decorum and behave orderly in the institute. Underlined acts are strictly prohibited in or around the institute/hostel premises.
 - a) The use of alcoholic beverages/drugs etc.
 - b) Gambling
 - c) The possession of fire arms or any lethal weapons.
 - d) Political activities in institution/hostel campus.
 - e) Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in institute/hostel campus. Use is a legal offence.
- Regular and punctual at lectures, demonstrations, practical, clinical classes, examinations, camps is compulsory. Students whose progress and conduct is not satisfactory will not be allowed to appear in the annual examination.
- The institute is not responsible for debits incurred by the students.
- The institute does not allow use of Principals office and Reception room for students.
- Students have to pay for all damages caused by them to books and other institute's property. Breakage of apparatus in excess of Rs. 50/- must be paid by the students.
- Illness and other ailments must be reported to the Superintendent immediately.
- The character of the candidates must be satisfactory during the training period.
- Students are not allowed to paste any notice etc. on the notice board or any where within the Institution without prior permission from the office of Principal and are forbidden to communicate with any outsider directly. All such communications must be submitted through the Principal who



- will forward. If the students break any of the rules, the institute authorities will be at liberty to take action against the students.
- Students will be relieved from the Institute after they have completed total clinical and field training and paid all dues.
- 10. A fine of Rs. 20/- per day will be charged from the absent students.
- Fee must be paid in full or in Instalments before 7th of every month after that a fine of Rs. 10/. per day will be charged.
- Institute reserves the rights to change the time table, rules, fee structure and holiday schedule at any time.
- Leaves will only be sanctioned on written application signed by the parents/guardians.
- 14. Institution is not responsible for any type of delay, not reaching the hospital/hostel/institute/training centre or any type of mishappening on the way. A strict action will be taken against the students involved in disobedience.
- 15. Ragging is strictly prohibited and is a punishable offence.
- 16. All disputes subjected to Jurisdiction of Jalandhar.
- The students will be allowed to appear for the final; examination only after clearing all institute dues. Roll Number will be issued after getting no dues slip.
- The students have to inform immediately to the authorities if they are sick. No sick student is allowed to stay in the hostel or institute without permission.
- Students will have to work in various sections in different hospitals. She/he will take care her/his CHASTITY MODESTY and WOMENHOOD.
- Students are directed to maintain discipline & avoid damage to the institute/hostel property. The loss will be compensated by the students.
- That the students will not consume any drug/chemical/ acid etc. in the institute/hostel/hospital, if they do, they will herself/himself be fully responsible.
- If a student avails leave without a genuine reason the absence will be marked in clinical practice by double the number of days. Leave will be sanctioned only for genuine reason.
- Students are not allowed to take up any other academic studies during Training. This is a regular course and no student can join any other course or do any part time jobs during this course training period/Studies.
- The students will have to submit a certificate of good character from any higher authority or reputed person of his/her area.
- 25. All original educational certificates submitted at the time of selection / admission will be retained by the institute until successful completion of the course and it will be returned only after clearance of all dues for complete course.

Rules And Regulations of The Hostel & Mess

- It is compulsory to stay in the hostel during the training period and join the mess.
- Mess charges are to be paid by the 7th of the month failing which the student will have to pay fine of Rs.20/- per day for the delayed period
- 3. The Mess crockery is not allowed to be taken in the living rooms.
- Food will not be served in the living rooms except in the case of sick students
- Modern dressings & Hair Styles will not be allowed. Students should look sober.
- Cot & furniture will be provided in the hostel. Students will have to bring their own bedding.
- 7. The sick students must inform to the head immediately.
- Cooking in the living room is strictly prohibited and no electrical appliances are allowed. No student of the hotel is allowed to cook any food.
- Students are not allowed to keep any costly things/ jewellary/Cash in their rooms and if kept, it will be entirely their own responsibility. Authorities are not responsible is case of any loss or damage.
- 10. Visitors are allowed to visit on following days to see their wards:
- a) Saturday: 2.00PMto 5.00PM b) Sunday: 10.00 AM to 5.00PM
- 11. Night stay of any guest is not allowed in the hostel.
- 12. No visitor will be allowed to see the students unless his/her specimen signatures & photograph have been provided to the institute duly counter signed by the father or guardian of the student.
- 13. Visitors list once given at the time of selection/admission along with photographs of the relatives will not be changed. All the problems concerning the hostel should be dealt with the Incharge.
- 14. Students are responsible for the care of furniture etc.
- 15. Every student should take responsibility to keep the rooms, bathrooms, toilets and wash room, neat and clean.
- Before leaving rooms, all students should check that all lights, fans and switches are switched off. Do not waste electricity & water.
- Boarders shall be allowed to go for shopping only with their parents or authorised guardians.
